

1.0 Purpose. The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for taking, retaining, and using photos and videos of participants at PMI Pikes Peak Regional, Colorado chapter (PPRC) events.

2.0 Application. This policy applies to all participants which include, but are not limited to, anyone attending a PPRC event: attendees (members and guests), presenters/instructors, and volunteers. PPRC events include, but are not limited to, monthly chapter meetings, workshops, seminars, breakfast meetings, roundtables, PDDs, and any PPRC events held at offsite locations.

3.0 Policy.

3.1 The Pikes Peak Regional, Colorado chapter (PPRC) of the Project Management Institute (PMI) reserves the right to use any photograph/video taken at an event sponsored by PPRC, without the written consent of those included within the photograph/video.

3.2 PPRC may use the photograph/video in materials produced, used or contracted by PPRC including but not limited to: brochures, invitations, books, newspapers, magazines, television, websites, marketing, etc.

3.3 All photographs and videos produced by PPRC can be used in the marketing and branding of the chapter and its events.

3.4 Personal use of a member's information, likeness, photograph, or video is prohibited.

3.5 PPRC will not identify attendees specifically without permission.
